

Candidate check List for Ordeals

Friday Night

All items for Friday night should be secured to or carried in a back pack.

- Eat Dinner prior to Arrival
- Wear Work Clothes
- Coat, Gloves, sweaters **weather dependant**
- Rain Gear of Choice
- Pack
- Water Bottle or Canteen filled with water (Secured to belt or pack frame)
- Hiking shoes or boots
- Hat or cap
- Ground cloth and/or plastic tarp to cover you and your sleeping bag
- Sleepng bag
- Non-aerosol bug repellent, sunblock and lip balm as necessary
- Have medications (if any) ready for turn in

- No flashlights, food, snacks, sodas, matches, hiking sticks, or electronics.

Saturday Cheerful Service

- Work clothes and shoes
- Work Gloves
- Hat or cap
- Coats and rain gear as necessary
- Water bottle or canteen

Saturday Night and Sunday morning:

- Personnel hygiene needs
- Change of clothes including socks.
- Class "A" Uniform on hanger. **Do not bring merit badge sash**
- Tent
- Sleeping Bag with pad if desired
- Pocket knife (**Do not bring non-folding knife**)
- Flash light & extra batteries
- Mosquito net (**optional**)

- There is no storage for valuables (money, radios, tape players, etc) during the Ordeal.
The equipment you need for Friday night must be packed separate from your personal gear to be used Saturday night and Sunday.

If you will be attending the ordeal with an adult from your troop, the equipment you need for Saturday Night and Sunday may remain in the vehicle until you need it. The adult must meet you at their vehicle in the parking lot at 4:00 PM Saturday afternoon and should not bring the equipment into the main camp.
